

Sidmouth 2026 – Walking Holiday – Walks Programme

This is a programme of suggested led walks for the group holiday 12-15th March 2026. Please note that members are free to do their own walks or to do Walks 8 & 9 on their own on any day. The RTVDs have been enhanced to include a contribution to car parking which is quite expensive on the coast.

Thursday 12th March

Walk 1 - Norman Lockyer Observatory 3.1 miles Grade 3

Coastal walk to the observatory, about 1.5 miles, stiff climb. Return via roads 1.5 miles. Depart hotel 1pm, tour starts 2 pm. A short introductory talk about Lockyer & the observatory, followed by a planetarium show and historic telescope tour and visit to the Lockyer Technology Centre for live meteor detecting. Tour lasts 2 hours, cost £10 per person. Can be done by car on the way to the hotel rather than walking from the hotel.

Friday 13th March

Walk 2 - Otterton Loop – 7 miles Grade 3 Starting from the Otter Estuary Nature Reserve car park. Follow the coastal path to Chiselbury Bay then inland to Otterton with (optional) lunch at Otterton Mill. Then follow the Otter River back to Budleigh Salterton.

Walk 3 - Otter River - 4.5 miles Grade 2. Starting from the Otter Estuary Nature Reserve car park follow the Otter River up to the Otterton Mill (optional lunch) then meet up with Walk 2 and walk back down the river to the car park.

Walk 4 - Beer Head – 3.2 miles Grade 4

Walk over South Downs Common to Branscombe Mouth then back over following the SWCP along the cliffs, Rugged. Café in Branscombe Mouth and refreshments in Beer

Saturday 14th March

Walk 5 - Colyton Circular – 6.5 miles – Grade 3

Follow river northwest to Heathayne then south to Holyford and back to Colyton.

Walk 6 - Donkey Sanctuary Circular – 4 miles Grade 3

Catch the 10.25 899 bus from Sidmouth to the Donkey Sanctuary then head along Dunscombe Coppice and along the coast path to Combe Wood, head inland to Salcombe Regis then back to the Donkey Sanctuary for lunch and a look around. Catch the 16.51 bus back to Sidmouth. (earlier bus as 14.21)

Walk 7 - Branscombe Loop – 3.9 miles Grade 3

Inland to Manor Hill and Branscombe and on to Street. Pick up the coastal path back to Branscombe Mouth.

Walk 8 - The Byes – 2 to 4 Miles Grade 2 (can be self guided)

Starting from Sidmouth follow the River Sid up to Sidford and then back the same route. Total 4 miles, turn earlier to reduce distance.

Walk 9 - Sidbury Tree Trail – 1.5 miles Grade 2 – Self Guided

Tree Trail Walk from the centre of Sidbury.
